



Logging Books, Earning eTickets & Entering Raffles!

On the app:

- Sign in to the Beanstack app with your email and Beanstack password.
- Tap the blue plus symbol in the bottom center of the screen.
- Tap **“Reading.”**
- Search for a title, select the book you read, and tap **“Save.”**
- Then tap **“Log Reading.”**
- Check off where it says, **“Did you finish this book?”** and tap **“Done”** at the bottom of the screen.
- Under **“Recent Titles,”** tap on the book you just read. Tap **“Add Review.”**
- Write 1-3 sentences telling us what you thought of the book. Then hit **“Post”** in the bottom right corner of the screen. *Congrats! You earned a badge and an eTicket!*
- In order to enter your eTicket into a raffle, tap on **“Adult Winter Reading Challenge”** under **“Current Challenges.”**
- Tap on **“Ticket Drawings”** on the right side of the menu.
- Tap on the raffle you would like to enter and hit **“Add/Remove Tickets.”**
- Enter 1 ticket and confirm your selection by tapping **“Add Tickets.”** *Congrats! You are now entered into that drawing. Winners will be drawn and contacted at the end of the winter!*

On the computer:

- Visit: emmaclark.beanstack.org/reader365
- Click **“Sign In”** in the top right corner. Log in with your email and Beanstack password.
- Click on the orange **“Log Reading”** button in the upper left corner of the screen. Then click, **“Log Books.”**
- Do not enter more than one book at a time. Search for the title and select your book from the dropdown suggestions.
- Select **“Yes”** where it says **“Would you like to include a review?”** Then click, **“Log Reading.”**
- Write 1-3 sentences telling us what you thought of the book. Then click **“Save.”**
- *Congrats! You earned a badge and an eTicket!* Click **“Enter a Drawing.”**
- Click on the raffle you would like to enter and click **“Add/Remove Tickets.”**
- Enter 1 ticket and confirm your selection by clicking the blue **“Enter”** button on the screen. You are now entered into that drawing. Winners will be drawn and contacted at the end of the winter!
